The attached School Report Card is a report of the 2009-2010 educational progress for Sequoyah Elementary. The report includes a collection of last year's testing (spring 2010), community characteristics and a summary of the educational process. It represents data from all public schools across the state of Oklahoma and is generated by our state Education Oversight Board. As you preview the report, you will see that the information provides our test results and also compares our student's performance in reading & math on the Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test to Oklahoma school averages.

The graphic representation indicates that 78% of last year's third grade students at Sequoyah scored Satisfactory & Above in math and 91% in reading. This also tells us Sequoyah's third grade students scored above the state average and district average in both core areas.

For last year's fourth grade students at Sequoyah, the graph indicates that 83% scored Satisfactory & Above in math and 79% in reading. This also tells us Sequoyah's fourth grade students scored above the state average and district average in both core areas.

It is our desire that you look over this report carefully. Please know that Sequoyah Elementary School will continue to strive for high academic performance. In addition, it is our goal to provide educational opportunities beyond these reported core areas of reading and math.

We recognize that our educational successes are directly impacted by your involvement. We firmly believe that the strong relationships we continue to build with our students and their families will help each student reach their full potential.
