Parents,

The attached School Report Card is a report of the 2009-2010 educational progress for *Tahlequah High School*. The report includes a collection of last year's testing (spring 2010), community characteristics and a summary of the educational process. It represents data from all public schools across the state of Oklahoma and is generated by our state Education Oversight Board. As you preview the report, you will see that the information provides our test results in seven academic areas as measured by State Department of Education End of Instruction tests. These tests compare our students' performance to Oklahoma high school averages state wide. These are the same tests that determine whether or not your child, when tested individually, will receive a graduation diploma.

The first graphic representation indicates the results in Algebra I. 75% of last year's Algebra I students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 78% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 3 % below State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in English II. 90% of last year's English II students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 87% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 3% above State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in U.S. History. 84% of last year's U. S. History students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 75% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 9% above State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in Biology. 85% of last year's Biology students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 78% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 7% above State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in Algebra II. 92% of last year's Algebra II students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 69% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 23% above State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in Geometry. 95% of last year's Geometry students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 83% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 12% above State averages.

The next graphic representation indicates the results in English III. 96% of last year's English III students at THS scored Satisfactory & Above while 87% of the State did so. This demonstrates that THS is 9% above State averages.

It is our desire that you look over this report carefully. Please know that Tahlequah High school will continue to strive for high academic performance. In addition, it is our goal to provide educational opportunities beyond these reported core areas.

We recognize that our educational successes are directly impacted by your involvement. We firmly believe that the strong relationships we continue to build with our students and their families will help each student reach their full potential.

We are proud of the accomplishments by our students. In six of the seven State measured academic areas, THS scored above the State averages. We feel that this is significant. In the area of Algebra I we have already introduced several changes which we think will demonstrate marked improvement. If you have any questions, please call our office at 458-4150.
